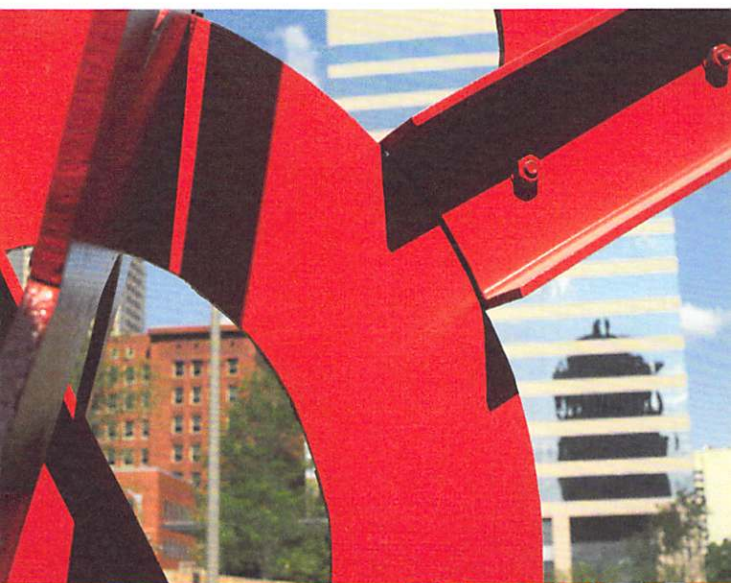
# WATER

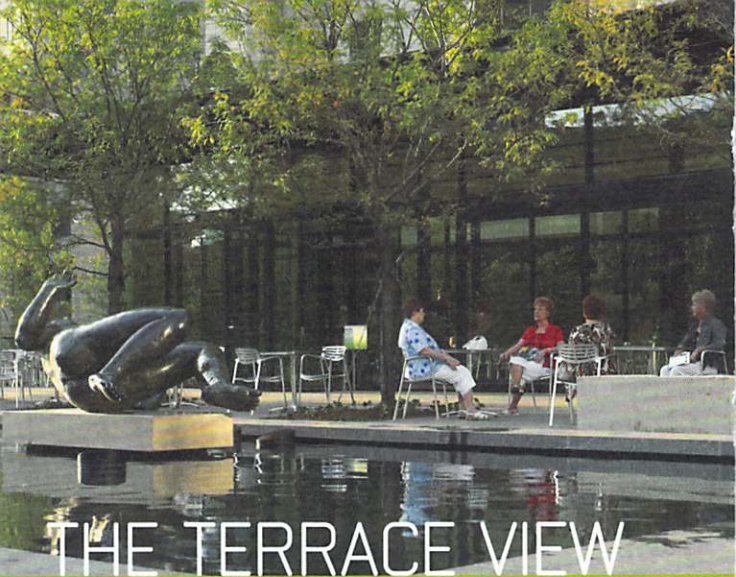
# ART

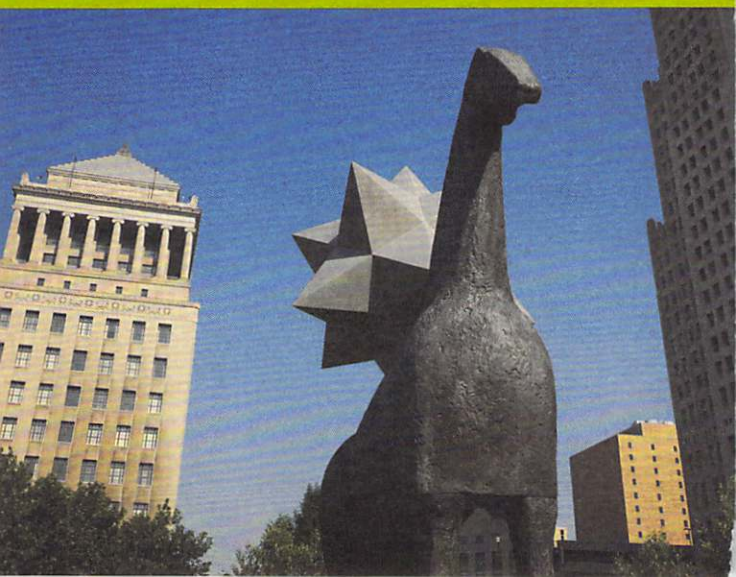
# PLANTS

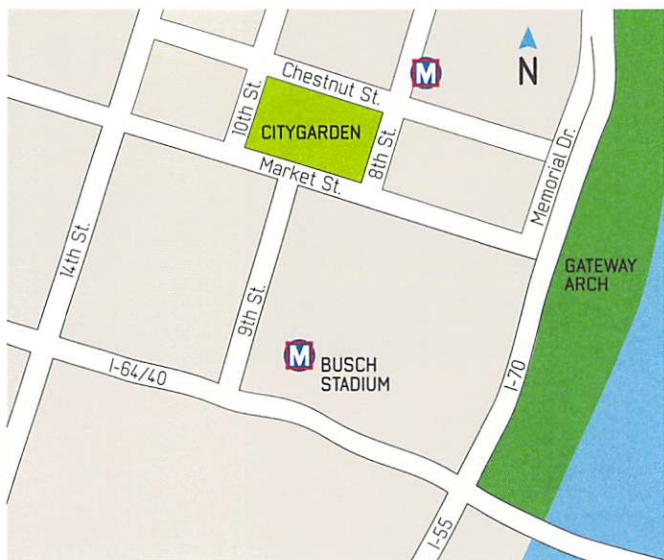


## THE TERRACE VIEW
