## **ADMISSION**

Admission to the Museum is free to all every day.

## **LOCATION**

The Saint Louis Art Museum is situated in Forest Park, one of the largest urban parks in the United States, just west of downtown St. Louis, Missouri, and is easily accessible from interstates 44 and 64/40, via the Hampton Avenue exit.

## **PARKING**

Visitor parking is to the north of the Museum, off of Fine Arts Drive; this includes group and school bus drop-off. Handicap accessible spaces are available in the northwest lot.
