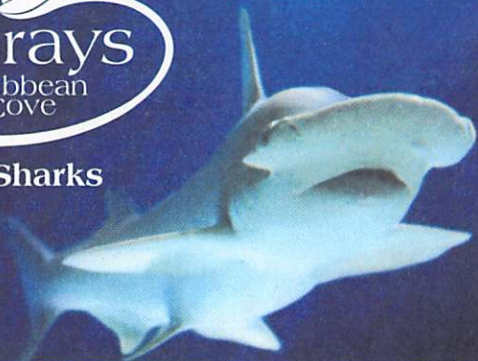

See penguins and puffins swim and play, watch a chimpanzee swing from tree-to-tree and take a spin on the Conservation Carousel in The Wild.



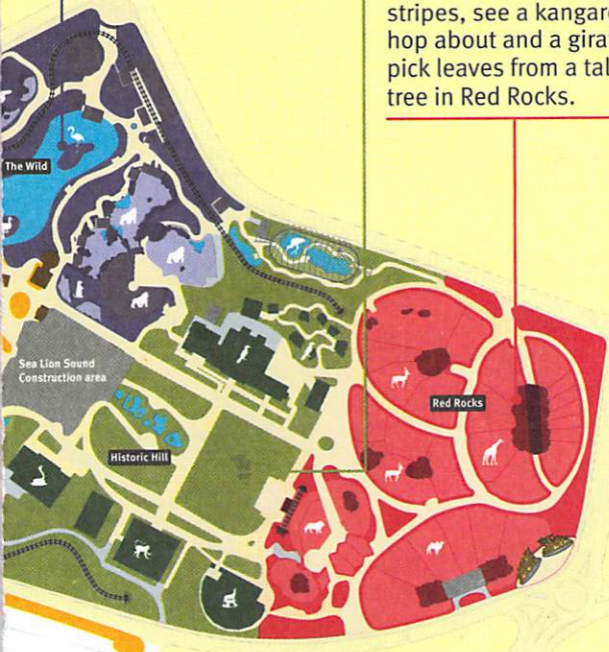
Historic Hill

How to Get Here:

From US 40/I-64

Take Hampton Avenue/
Museums – Zoo exit 34-D.

From I-44

Take Hampton Avenue exit,
north one mile to the Zoo.

From I-270

Take I-170 south to
US 40/I-64 east to Museums
– Zoo exit 34-D.

By Metrolink

Ride the MetroLink to the
Forest Park-DeBaliviere
station and transfer to the #3
Forest Park Trolley.

By Bus

From May through October,
you can take the bus to Forest
Park-DeBaliviere MetroLink
station and transfer to the #3
Forest Park Trolley.

After October 31, the #90
Hampton bus stops within a
short walking distance from
the Zoo's North Entrance on
Government Drive.
